

What do I need to consider when upgrading to a VR-10 computer from a VR-2002E or a PMP 4203 mechanical computer?

1. Changing the Price Per Gallon

The VR-10 computer prices as follows:

- Less than \$5.999 per gallon, it prices by 1/10 cents, with a maximum sale of \$999.98
- Greater than \$5.999 per gallon, it prices in even cents with a maximum sale of \$999.98

Changing the price on a VR-10 computer requires changing a stack of colored gears in a specific sequence for each \$1.00 price range. Instructions are included on the band of the computer. Price setting instructions are also available on the PMP website under the FAQ tab. The most common problem encountered in changing prices is skipping step #4 – removing the vertical pin.

The VR-10 can also be set up to operate at even or whole cents below \$5.999. The advantage is that all price changes are accomplished by moving only the range arms. Instructions to set up the VR-10 to operate in this manner are on the PMP website under the FAQ tab.

2. Pulsers

If the installation uses a pulser, the pulser will need to be upgraded.

Standard pulsers, such as Veeder-Root 7697, 1871 and pulse-totalizer, Gilbarco T18350 G series and the Western 400, were not designed to operate at the speed of the VR-10 computers.

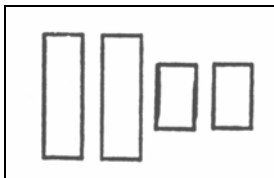
Following are possible pulser alternatives. Please check with individual manufacturers for system compatibility.

- a. Veeder-Root manufactures a pulse-totalizer specifically for the VR-10 computer.
- b. OPW (Western) 500 Pulser - This will work with dispensers with one computer.
If there are two computers in the dispenser, there may not be enough space to fit two pulsers.
- c. Integrated Control Systems (ICS) has a Model SP1 Pulser that is compatible with many computers including the VR-10. The small size of the SP1 will fit most dual computer dispensers. 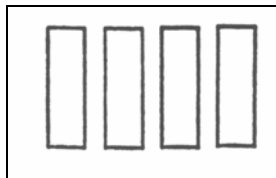
3. Computer Faceplate

There is a difference in the faceplate on a VR-10 computer versus other models.

To use a faceplate from a VR-10/4, VR-2002E, PMP 4203 or PMP 4005 the right two windows have to be enlarged.
